

Roles & Responsibilities/ Athlete representatives IPC Sports

- Candidates should have a keen interest in their sport and the Paralympic Movement
- The majority of the work is conducted over E-mail, so it is therefore highly recommended that candidates have access to this communication medium.
- Candidates should be available to attend World Para Dance Sport Technical Committee (STC) meetings. The STC usually meets once a year for two days. Meeting dates are communicated well in advance and also take personal training and competition commitments into consideration where possible.
- Athlete representatives are requested to actively participate in discussions on athleterelated issues and concerns in between the official meetings.
- Athlete representatives are requested to provide input to the meeting agenda and feedback to meeting minutes, as well as the Athletes' viewpoint and wishes.
- Athlete representatives may be asked to attend or host athletes' meetings at major sport competitions.
- Athlete representatives are responsible for reporting regularly to the IPC Athletes' Council when requested.
- Athletes representative are asked to regularly consult with the athletes population and represent their best interests.
- To liaise with the World Para Dance Sport management team and appropriate member Athletes Council.
- To serve as a STC member.
