NOTICE OF OPEN COMPARATIVE PROCEDURE

FIDESM - Italian DanceSport and Musical Sports Federation launches an open comparative procedure for the award of the services and supplies required for the technical set-up of the International DanceSport Championships - Rome - 2, 3 and 4 October 2026, and the Congresses of 30 September, 1 October and 5 October 2026.

The procedure is private in nature and is not governed by the Public Procurement Code. It is governed by Articles 1326 et seq. of the Italian Civil Code; therefore, any disputes shall fall under ordinary civil jurisdiction rather than administrative jurisdiction.

The procedure is divided into autonomous and specialist functional lots.

The following may participate:

- individual economic operators;
- temporary associations of undertakings (ATI/RTI);
- aggregations of specialist companies.

Where participation is through an ATI/RTI, the lead company must be identified, with an indication of the shares and activities assigned to each participating company.

Reliance on the capacities of other entities (avvalimento) is not permitted, in view of the specialist nature of the services and the need to ensure direct operational experience of the participating economic operators.

The contract will be awarded on the basis of the most economically advantageous tender, identified according to the best quality/price ratio.

FIDESM reserves the right to award the contract even where only one valid tender is received, provided that it is considered appropriate and technically suitable. FIDESM also reserves the right to suspend, cancel or revoke the procedure at any time, without participants being entitled to claims or compensation.

FULL PROCEDURE RULES

Article 1 - Subject matter

The procedure concerns the award of supply, transport, installation, technical assistance during the event, maintenance and subsequent dismantling of the technical set-ups required for the event. All activities must be performed in a workmanlike manner and in compliance with current rules on safety, fire prevention, systems and public entertainment.

Article 2 - Duration

Set-up activities shall take place from 28 September to 1 October 2026, exclusively between 08:00 and 24:00 for the arena floor, and on 28-29 September 2026 for the congress area / second dance floor. Dismantling shall take place from 5 to 6 October 2026, exclusively between 08:00 and 24:00. Technical assistance shall be provided throughout the event from 30 September to 5 October 2026.

Article 3 - Deadline for submission of tenders

Tenders must be received within 15 calendar days from publication of the procedure on the Federation's official portal and, in any case, by 14 September 2026 at 18:00. Tenders must contain:

- A) administrative documentation;
- B) technical offer;
- C) financial offer.

Tenders received after the deadline will not be admitted.

Site inspection

Interested companies may request a technical site inspection of the areas concerned by the event. If requested, the inspection will take place on 8 September 2026. Organisational details will be communicated by FIDESM. Failure to carry out the inspection will not constitute grounds for exclusion.

Article 4 - Participation requirements

General requirements

- registration with the Chamber of Commerce for activities consistent with the lot applied for; for economic operators established in EU Member States or third countries, registration in the relevant professional or commercial register in the country of establishment, suitable to demonstrate performance of the activities concerned, together with equivalent evidence of social-security and welfare compliance issued by the competent authorities or, where unavailable, a sworn declaration;
- compliance with social-security and insurance obligations;
- appropriate third-party and employer's liability insurance (RCT/RCO);
- absence of final criminal convictions against directors, without prejudice to any organisational model under Italian Legislative Decree 231/2001.

Technical and professional capacity

- availability of specialised technical staff;
- availability of suitable equipment, vehicles and structures.

Article 5 - Award criterion

The award will be made using the most economically advantageous tender criterion.

Article 6 - Technical assistance

The successful contractor shall guarantee: technical assistance during all official competition hours; immediate availability of technical staff; prompt intervention in the event of failures or anomalies; immediate replacement of defective components.

Article 7 - Insurance policies

Contractors must hold RCT and RCO insurance and coverage for damage to persons or property. Minimum coverage limits: EUR 2,500,000.00.

Article 8 - Safety

All work shall comply with current occupational safety legislation. Operators must use appropriate PPE, comply with instructions from the event management and coordinate with other operators present.

Article 9 - Penalties

Delay in set-up:

EUR 500.00 per hour; failure to provide technical assistance: EUR 1,000.00 per event;

technical non-compliance: EUR 500.00 to EUR 5,000.00;

delay in dismantling: EUR 500.00 per hour.

FIDESM retains the right to claim compensation for any greater damage.

Article 10 - Subcontracting

Subcontracting is permitted subject to prior authorisation by FIDESM. The contractor remains solely responsible for performance of the activities.

Article 11 - Payments

Payments will be made following verification of proper performance, issuance of an invoice and verification of social-security compliance. Invoices must state the lot awarded.

Article 12 - Submission method

Tenders must be submitted by **14 September 2026 at 18:00** in digital format to the certified email address amministrazionefids@pec.it. Documentation must be divided into:

D) administrative documentation; E) technical offer; F) financial offer.

Missing essential documentation may result in exclusion.

Article 13 - Administrative documentation

Participants must submit: updated Chamber of Commerce certificate; valid DURC; copy of the legal representative's identity document; declaration of possession of requirements; RCT/RCO insurance policy; any quality certifications held.

Article 14 - Evaluation Commission

Tenders will be assessed by a Commission appointed by FIDESM. The Commission will verify administrative documentation, assess technical offers, allocate scores, open financial offers and draw up the final ranking.

Article 15 - Tender validity

Tenders shall remain binding on economic operators for at least 90 days from the final submission deadline.

Article 16 - Guarantees

FIDESM may require a provisional guarantee, final guarantee and/or surety guarantees. Amounts and procedures will be communicated to participants if applicable.

Article 17 - Contractor obligations

The contractor shall ensure full operability of the set-ups, keep structures efficient, provide qualified technical staff, coordinate with event management, and comply with the timetable and safety provisions.

Article 18 - Personnel

All personnel employed must be regularly hired, trained in safety matters, use the required PPE and be identifiable by badge.

Article 19 - Vehicles and equipment

Participants must have suitable transport vehicles, certified equipment, compliant systems and any required platforms and fall-protection systems.

Article 20 - Safety and coordination

Contractors shall coordinate with event management and other operators to avoid operational interference. All activities shall comply with current occupational safety legislation.

Article 21 - Termination

FIDESM may terminate the award in the event of serious breach, failure to comply with safety requirements, delays incompatible with the timetable, or loss of declared requirements.

Article 22 - Data processing

Personal data acquired within the procedure will be processed exclusively for purposes connected with management of the selection and the resulting contractual relationship, in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) and applicable Italian data-protection legislation.

Article 23 - Disputes

The Court of Rome shall have jurisdiction over any disputes.

Article 24 - Final provisions

Participation entails full acceptance of all conditions contained in the documentation prepared by FIDESM. For matters not expressly provided for, the general principles of civil and commercial law shall apply.

DUVRI - GENERAL INDICATIONS

Contractors shall coordinate with one another in order to avoid interference during loading/unloading, material handling, structure assembly, use of platforms and vehicles, work at height and electrical power-supply activities. All personnel must be identifiable by badge.

LOT 1 - DANCE FLOORS AND CARPET

Subject of the lot

Supply, transport, installation, levelling, maintenance during the event and subsequent dismantling of modular dance floors intended for DanceSport competitions. Supply and installation of film-protected fire-retardant carpet, thickness 13-15 mm, and temporary coverings for competition areas, backstage areas, technical routes, stands and common areas.

Included services

- modular dance floors;
- technical subfloors;
- transition profiles;
- surface levelling;
- fabric tapes, connecting straps and hardware where required;
- any technical platforms;
- technical assistance during the event;
- dismantling and final removal;

Reason for subdivision

Autonomous service relating to exhibition set-ups and temporary coverings. Highly specialised service requiring specific technical expertise in temporary sports surfaces.

The purpose is to obtain an offer for the scenic set-up of 2 competition fields for the International DanceSport Championships - Rome - 2, 3 and 4 October 2026. Set-up: 28 September-1 October 2026. Dismantling: 5-6 October 2026. Working hours: 08:00-24:00. The basement room used as changing room and congress room must be completed on 28-29 September.

IMPORTANT: the basement rooms must be fully completed by 20:00 on 29 September 2026 and the arena-floor set-up by 20:00 on 1 October 2026, to allow WDSF officials to carry out inspections for approval of the event.

Technical specifications

Supply and installation of two wooden dance floors, either owned by the contractor or, alternatively, owned by FIDESM and to be collected from and returned after use to the Federation warehouse in Santarcangelo di Romagna (RN):

- 1 floor measuring 28.00 m x 16.00 m for the arena floor;
- 1 floor measuring 22.00 m x 12.00 m for the basement room;
- black film-protected fire-retardant carpet, thickness 13-15 mm: 800 m² arena floor; 300 m² basement room; 150 m² basement corridor.

Total for set-up/dismantling of floors and supply/installation of carpet for the two areas: EUR 20,000.00 excluding VAT. Upward bids are not permitted.

The contractor must provide all necessary certifications at the end of set-up and to the event safety manager on the day before the event, including: certificate of correct assembly; structural calculation and static suitability report; fire-retardancy certificates for materials. The installer must also provide at least one technical-assistance staff member throughout the event, transport, handling/loading/unloading, assembly and dismantling.

LOT 3 - AUDIO, LIGHTING AND LED WALL SYSTEMS

Supply, installation and operation of audio systems, show lighting and technical control systems, including LED walls. Included: audio systems, mixers/control desks, loudspeakers, scenic lighting, cabling, electrical panels, technical assistance, audio/lighting operators, LED walls, structural supports and content management.

Requirements include declarations of conformity, qualified personnel, compliance with CEI standards, electrical safety certifications, CE-certified professional indoor systems and specialised staff. The set-up/dismantling timetable and WDSF inspection deadlines are the same as specified above.

AUDIO SYSTEM

Supply, transport, assembly, technical assistance, operation and dismantling of a professional audio system for DanceSport competitions or similar structures, including sound reinforcement, audio control, cabling, power supply and specialised technical staff.

The system must ensure uniform coverage of the competition area, adequate speech intelligibility, high musical performance for DanceSport disciplines, no audible distortion and continuous operation throughout the event.

Minimum performance requirements:

- Total minimum power: 12,000 W RMS actual.
- Uniform sound pressure on the dance floor: minimum 98 dB(A) continuous; peaks not lower than 105 dB(A).
- At least 2 main line-array clusters, 4 professional subwoofers, control-room monitors and speaker/judges monitors.
- Professional digital mixer with at least 12 channels, digital EQ, DSP processors, audio-zone management, backup recording and professional audio players.
- Minimum microphones: 2 wireless microphones and 1 desk microphone for judges/presenter.
- Conference room / second floor: dedicated audio system, 2 radio microphones, 1 headset microphone and audio/video control.

All cabling must be CE-certified, fire-retardant, installed in a workmanlike manner and protected against crushing and trip hazards. The system must include declaration of conformity, electrical-system certification, technical data sheets and fire certifications for materials.

Continuous presence of at least one audio technician, immediate emergency availability and immediate replacement of faulty equipment are required. One secondary 8-channel audio mixer is also required.

LIGHTING SYSTEM

The lighting system shall include 34 LED PAR fixtures of at least 144 W installed on scenic trusses and 12 beam moving heads with lamps of at least 300 W.

Professional dance-floor lighting must be supplied, installed, programmed and operated with suspended fixtures at $h \geq 8.50$ m. The supply includes transport, assembly, testing, assistance during the events and dismantling. It shall use aerial suspensions supplied by the contractor, with a 30 cm aluminium ring measuring 17.00 x 7.00 m and 4 aluminium portals measuring 7.00 m with minimum height 7.00 m.

Lighting must be uniform and free of shadow cones, suitable for competition and scenic enhancement, guaranteeing at least 1,200 lux measured 1 m above floor level, evenly distributed across the entire competition field, with colour temperature 3,200 K.

- executive lighting design;
- technical suspended-load report;
- supply and installation of certified aluminium trusses;
- CE-certified electric motors/hoists with chains, eyebolts, safety ropes and accessories;
- dedicated electrical panel; electrical lines; three-phase and single-phase distribution;
- professional high-colour-rendering LED projectors;

- digital lighting console using DMX/Art-Net;
- DMX control units and splitters; signal and power cabling;
- backup power for control room;
- specialised staff for assembly and lighting control;
- declarations of conformity under Italian Ministerial Decree 37/2008; CE certifications; electrical diagrams and plans;
- continuous technical assistance and final dismantling/restoration;
- DMX console with operator;
- conference room / second floor: 6 lighting towers with 2 lamps each, approx. 4.00 m high;
- 2 lighting towers with 2 fixtures each, positioned beside the orchestra banner.

LED WALLS

- LED wall 5.00 x 3.00 m, central scenic section, pixel pitch at least 4.8, installed on central truss, with dedicated scaler/content-management system.
- 4 LED walls 1.50 x 4.00 m positioned in the side scenic structures as per attached drawing, each with dedicated scaler/content-management system.
- LED wall 5.50 x 2.50 m for the congress room, installed on aluminium portal, pixel pitch at least 4.8, with dedicated scaler/content-management system.

TEMPORARY ELECTRICAL SYSTEM

Supply, transport, installation, activation, technical management, in-service maintenance and dismantling of complete temporary electrical systems for competitions, sports events, shows, technical areas, audio/video/lighting control rooms, dance floors and LED walls. The system must guarantee continuity of service, safety, adequate power distribution and full operation of all installed equipment.

- executive design of the temporary electrical system;
- CE-certified main and secondary switchboards;
- main and terminal distribution lines; three-phase and single-phase feeders;
- FG16OR18 cables or equivalent CPR;
- walkable cable trays, conduits and protection;
- distribution for dance floors, audio, lighting, LED walls, TV/video control rooms, judges' stations, UPS and IT systems;
- industrial CEE sockets of suitable rating; distributed socket towers and outlets;
- equipotential earthing systems; selective circuit breakers and RCDs;
- emergency systems and safety lighting; equipotential bonding of metal structures;
- electrical-load verification and phase balancing;
- continuous technical assistance and emergency response during competitions;
- final dismantling and restoration.

Mandatory documentation: general electrical diagram, distribution plans, technical report, declaration of conformity under Ministerial Decree 37/2008, CE certifications for materials, earthing-system certification.

Reference rules: Italian Ministerial Decree 37/2008; Legislative Decree 81/2008 as amended; CEI 64-8; CEI 64-17; CEI EN 61439; current fire-prevention regulations.

Total audio, lighting and LED-wall systems: EUR 25,000.00 excluding VAT. Upward bids are not permitted.

The contractor must provide the required electrical conformity declarations and general electrical-system diagram/project to the event safety manager on the day before the event. The installer must also provide at least one technical-assistance staff member throughout the event, transport, handling/loading/unloading, assembly and dismantling.

Materials must be certified, suitable for indoor use and compliant with safety regulations.
